- Tuition is based upon 65 credits in the curriculum and represents estimates that are subject to change and should be used only for planning purposes. (Bucks County, PA residents have been granted an "out of county" rate by special arrangement between MCCC and Bucks County Community College.)
- Lab supplies include a lab coat, name-tag, patch, stethoscope, 2 goniometers, and a graduation fee.
- Textbooks: estimate based upon the cost of new required books for the courses
- Tuition includes: (college fees and technology fees which are charged based upon the number of credits)
- Other: includes lab course fees for lab courses and clinical liability insurance for clinical courses

Lab Coats

Lab Coats are required for competency testing and Clinical Education courses. The lab coat must have a patch on the Left shoulder that indicates Mercer County Community College Physical Therapy, and student/learners must also wear a name tag that indicates their name and MCCC PTA Student. These items are available from either *Life Uniform* in the Mercer Mall or *Belle Uniform*, a company that comes on campus each August so that lab coats, name tags and patches can be ordered specifically for the PTA program and other Health Professions programs. *Belle Uniform* is the sole provider of the patches and they will sew them onto lab coats at no additional cost. Together, the required items cost approximately \$40.00.
