Successfully completed <u>all of the other courses listed as required courses</u> with a grade of C or higher and if those courses were completed at another institution, making sure that official copies of the transcripts are on file in the Enrollment Services Office at Mercer and that the time periods are still current.
- 4. Attended one of the PTA program information sessions.
