Petition for the Professional Phase

The process for acceptance of 24 individuals into the professional phase is based upon the following:

- 1. Selecting and assuring that your are listed as a Physical Therapist Assistant major
- 2. Successfully completing PTA 101 Intro to PTA and PTA 105 Kinesiology with a grade of C+ or higher (these may be in progress during the time of the submission of the Petition)
- 3. Successfully completing Anatomy & Physiology II with a grade of C or higher at the same institution where Anatomy & Physiology I was completed (this may be in progress during the time of the submission of the Petition)
- 4. Successfully completed all of the courses that need to be completed with a grade of C or higher and if those courses were taken at another institution, making sure that the transcripts are on file at Mercer and that the time periods are still current
- 5. Semester of first matriculation at Mercer (those who have waited longer will be accepted first)
- 6. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required for consideration as a candidate for the Professional Phase of the Physical Therapist Assistant program (transfer credit does not carry a GPA, only the credit transfers)

Additional Information:

- Applicants will be notified by mail <u>after</u> Spring Break.
- A short wait list will be maintained and those who are on that list will also be notified that they are
 waitlisted. Those individuals should be prepared to potentially receive a telephone call up to or
 including the first day of class in the first summer session. Since all acceptances are provisional and
 based upon the successful completion of courses currently in progress during the spring semester
 some changes usually take place after spring grades post.
