## Mercer County Community College Physical Therapist Assistant Program

### **Petition for the Professional Phase**

The process for acceptance of 28 individuals into the professional phase is based upon the following:

- 1. Your semester of first matriculation at Mercer as a PTA major is very important. (Those who took courses at Mercer as PTA majors in earlier semesters will be accepted before those who just started taking courses at Mercer as a PTA major. If someone took courses at Mercer years ago under a different major that would not "start the clock" for them as a PTA major until he or she completes a change of major form and then takes a course as a PTA major)
- 2. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required for consideration as a candidate for the Professional Phase of the Physical Therapist Assistant program (transfer credit does not carry a GPA, only the credit transfers)
- 3. Selecting and assuring that your are listed as a Physical Therapist Assistant major
- 4. Successfully completing PTA 101 Intro to PTA and PTA 105 Kinesiology with a grade of C+ or higher through MCCC. Transfer credit for PTA prefixed courses will not be considered for credit.
- 5. Successfully completing Anatomy & Physiology I and II with grades of C+ or higher at the same institution where Anatomy & Physiology I was completed
- 6. Successfully completed <u>all of the courses that need to be completed</u> with a grade of C or higher and if those courses were taken at another institution, making sure that official copies of the transcripts are on file at Mercer and that the time periods are still current

#### **Additional Information:**

- The Admissions Office is responsible for the selection process based upon the criteria listed above.
- All petitioners will be notified by mail <u>after Spring Break</u>.
- A short wait list will be maintained and those who are on that list will also be notified that they are wait-listed. Those individuals should be prepared to potentially receive a telephone call up to or including the first day of class in the first summer session.
- If after being notified that you are either provisionally accepted or waitlisted, you decide that you do NOT want to be a part of the PTA program, you must notify the PTA Program Coordinator in writing of your decision.
- If a petitioner was not accepted and decides to petition again but will not be taking classes at Mercer, it is the responsibility of the petitioner to complete a Leave of Absence form with the Registrar's Office and maintain communication with the PTA Program Coordinator via email.
- The PTA program website should be consulted for additional information regarding registration questions.
- Those who are petitioning for <u>re-admission</u> into the professional phase of the PTA program after a leave of absence from the **Professional Phase of the PTA program** are not guaranteed re-acceptance. He or she could potentially earn a seat based upon availability in the semester in which he or she needs to re-start, based upon the successful completion of a re-entry practical examination that demonstrates competence in the skills that had previously been mastered for all lab courses. Timelines are listed in the Student/learner Handbook which is posted on the PTA program website.
